

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
CAMAK ROAD PUMP STATION AND FORCE MAIN
for the
WARREN COUNTY, GEORGIA**

Sealed proposals will be received by Warren County Board of Commissioners at P.O. Box 46 or 521 Main Street, Warrenton, Georgia 30828 until 2:00 P.M. local time, Thursday, June 27, 2019 at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of ninety (90) days.

All Bidders must have a State of Georgia Utility Contractor License and must employ a state "Utility Manager" certificate holder who will have oversight of all the work.

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment and labor for the construction of:

Division One: Sewer Lines

Approximately 12,200 L.F. of 6-inch PVC and ductile iron force main, with 5 air release valve manholes and all appurtenances. Time allotted for this work is 180 consecutive calendar days.

Division Two: Sewage Pump Station

Construction of a new sewage pump station including site work, wetwell, gravity sewerage connection, piping, fencing, access drive, electrical, pumps, painting, and all appurtenances. Time allotted for this work is 270 consecutive calendar days.

Proposals for the complete work in one or more general contracts shall be made on the proposal form provided and shall contain prices in words and figures for the work bid on.

The project is proposed to be funded with a State Revolving Fund loan. All SRF and American Iron and Steel Special Conditions requirements apply.

All proposals shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond drawn in favor of Warren County, Georgia, in the amount of at least 10% of the lump sum bid for the complete work; such Bid Bond representing that the Bidder, if awarded the contract, will promptly enter into a contract and furnish Performance Bond and Payment Bond as provided by law and approved by the Attorney for Warren County, Georgia. Each bond shall be equal to 100% of the contract amount. The Bid Bond shall be forfeited to Warren County, Georgia as liquidated damages if the Bidder fails to execute the contract and provide Performance and Payment Bonds within 10 days after being notified that he has been awarded the contract.

Drawings and Specifications are open to public inspection at the office of the Warren County, Georgia; at the office Turnipseed Engineers in Augusta and Atlanta, Georgia and the Atlanta Builders Exchange in Atlanta.

Upon receipt of all documents in undamaged condition within 30 days after the date of opening of bids, half of the deposit will be refunded.

The difference between the deposit and the amount refunded represents the cost of reproduction. No refund will be made for documents received after 30 days or in damaged condition.
