

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
HIGHWAY 29 INDUSTRIAL PARK IMPROVEMENTS
FOR THE
CITY OF SOPERTON, GEORGIA**

Sealed proposals will be received by the City of Soperton, Georgia, 1973 Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive, Soperton, Georgia 30457 until 2:00 P.M. local time, Tuesday, June 11, 2019, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

All Bidders must have a State of Georgia Utility Contractor License and must employ a state "Utility Manager" certificate holder who will have oversight of all the work.

Work to be done: The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment and labor for the construction of:

Division One: Water Line and Force Main Improvements

Install approximately 150 L.F. of 10-inch D.I. water line, 120 L.F. of 16-inch steel casing by jack and bore, 5,319 L.F. of 6-inch PVC and 290 L.F. of 6-inch D.I. force main, 4 combination vacuum and air release valves with manholes, 180 L.F. 12-inch steel casing by jack and bore with appurtenances and stormwater monitoring. Time allotted for this work is 180 consecutive calendar days.

Division Two: Pump Station

Construction of one duplex submersible raw sewage pump station including wetwell, piping, electrical, submersible pumps, grading, access drive, grassing and fencing. Time allotted for this work is 210 consecutive calendar days.

Proposals for the complete work in one or more general contracts shall be made on the proposal form provided and shall contain prices in words and figures for the work bid on.

All proposals shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond drawn in favor of the City of Soperton, Georgia, in the amount of at least ten percent (10%) of the lump sum bid for the complete work; such Bid Bond representing that the Bidder, if awarded the contract, will promptly enter into a contract and furnish Performance Bond and Payment Bond as provided by law and approved by the Attorney for the City of Soperton, Georgia. Each bond shall be equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount. The Bid Bond shall be forfeited to the City of Soperton, Georgia as liquidated damages if the Bidder fails to execute the contract and provide Performance and Payment Bonds within ten (10) days after being notified that he has been awarded the contract.

Drawings and Specifications are open to public inspection at the office of the City of Soperton, Georgia; the office of Turnipseed Engineers in Augusta and Atlanta, Georgia and the Atlanta Builders Exchange in Atlanta, Georgia.

Upon receipt of all documents in undamaged condition within thirty (30) days after the date of opening of bids, one-half of the deposit will be refunded.
