

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
WATER TREATMENT PLANT – FILTER REHABILITATION
FOR THE
CITY OF LAGRANGE, GEORGIA**

Sealed proposals will be received by the City of LaGrange, Georgia at City Hall, 200 Ridley Avenue, Room 301 (Office of Purchasing), LaGrange, Georgia 30240 until 2:00 p.m. local time, Thursday, April 26, 2018, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

All Bidders must have a State of Georgia Utility Contractor License and must employ a state “Utility Manager” certificate holder who will have oversight of all the work.

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment and labor for the construction of:

Remove and dispose of existing filter media and underdrain from one (1) filter in the 1949 plant section and one (1) filter in the 1993 plant section. Install new filter underdrains and filter media at both locations. Media disposal will be onsite in a location designated by the Owner.

Time allotted for construction is 120 consecutive calendar days for substantial completion and 150 days for final completion.

Proposals for the complete work in one general contract shall be made on the proposal form provided and shall contain prices in words and figures for the work bid on.

All proposals shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond drawn in favor of the City of LaGrange, Georgia, in the amount of at least 10% of the lump sum bid for the complete work; such Bid Bond representing that the Bidder, if awarded the contract, will promptly enter into a contract and furnish Performance Bond and Payment Bond as provided by law and approved by the Attorney for the City of LaGrange, Georgia. Each bond shall be equal to 100% of the contract amount. The Bid Bond shall be forfeited to the City of LaGrange, Georgia as liquidated damages if the Bidder fails to execute the contract and provide Performance and Payment Bonds within 10 days after being notified that he has been awarded the contract.

Drawings and Specifications are open to public inspection at the office of the City of LaGrange, Georgia; at the Turnipseed Engineers offices in Augusta and Atlanta,

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.
