

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
MODIFICATIONS TO THE BELLS FERRY ROAD
BOOSTER PUMP STATION
FOR
FLOYD COUNTY, GEORGIA**

Sealed proposals will be received by the Floyd County Board of Commissioners at the Floyd County Purchasing Department, 12 East 4th Avenue, Rome, Georgia 30161 until 2:00 p.m. local time, Tuesday, March 31, 2020, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read. No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of sixty (60) days.

All Bidders must have a State of Georgia Utility Contractor License and must employ a state "Utility Manager" certificate holder who will have oversight of all the work.

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment and labor for the construction of:

Upgrades to the Bells Ferry Road Booster Pump Station, including upgraded pumps, electrical, controls and SCADA integration, complete with appurtenances

Time allotted for construction is 180 consecutive calendar days for substantial completion and 210 days for final completion.

Proposals for the complete work in one general contract shall be made on the proposal form provided and shall contain prices in words and figures for the work bid on.

All proposals shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond drawn in favor of Floyd County, Georgia in the amount of at least 10% of the lump sum bid for the complete work; such Bid Bond representing that the Bidder, if awarded the contract, will promptly enter into a contract and furnish Performance Bond and Payment Bond as provided by law and approved by the Attorney for Floyd County, Georgia. Each bond shall be equal to 100% of the contract amount. The Bid Bond shall be forfeited to Floyd County, Georgia as liquidated damages if the Bidder fails to execute the contract and provide Performance and Payment Bonds within 10 days after being notified that he has been awarded the contract.

Drawings and Specifications are open to public inspection at the office of the Floyd County, Georgia Board of Commissioners; at the office Turnipseed Engineers in Augusta and Atlanta, Georgia and the Atlanta Builders Exchange in Atlanta.

In accordance with State of Georgia HB489, this project has been posted to the Georgia Procurement Registry as provided by Code Section 50-5-69.
