

**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF
WATER SUPPLY PRODUCTION WELL 2A
CDBG FUNDING

TOWN OF DEXTER, GEORGIA**

Sealed proposals for the Town of Dexter, Georgia will be received by the Town of Dexter 101 N. Main Street, Dexter, Georgia 31019 until 2:00 p.m. local time, Tuesday, May 18, 2021. No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of 60 days.

All Bidders must have a State of Georgia Well Drillers License and be a member of the Georgia Water Well Drillers Association.

The work to be done consists of furnishing all materials, equipment and labor for the construction of:

The development and testing of a water supply production well 2A, including well house, SCADA connections, electrical, piping, connection to the existing system and including all appurtenances required to bring well online in the Town Water System.

Time allotted for construction is 30 consecutive calendar days for substantial completion and 60 days for final completion.

Proposals for the complete work in one general contract shall be made on the proposal form provided and shall contain prices in words and figures for the work bid on.

This is a Section 3 Covered Project under the HUD Act of 1968 and Section 3 Residents and Business Concerns are encouraged to apply. The Town of Dexter, Georgia is committed to providing all persons with equal access to its services, programs, activities, education, and employment regardless of race, color, national origin, religion, sex, familial status, disability or age.

The project is proposed to be funded with a State Revolving Fund loan. All SRF and American Iron and Steel Special Conditions requirements apply.

All proposals shall be accompanied by a Bid Bond drawn in favor of the Town of Dexter, Georgia, in the amount of at least 10% of the lump sum bid for the complete work; such Bid Bond representing that the Bidder, if awarded the contract, will promptly enter into a contract and furnish Performance Bond and Payment Bond as provided by law and approved by the Attorney for the Town of Dexter, Georgia. Each bond shall be equal to 100% of the contract amount. The Bid Bond shall be forfeited to the Town of Dexter, Georgia as liquidated damages if the Bidder fails to execute the contract and provide Performance and Payment Bonds within 10 days after being notified that he has been awarded the contract.

Bidding documents are open to public inspection at the office of the Town of Dexter, Georgia and at the offices of Turnipseed Engineers in Augusta and Atlanta, Georgia.

Copies of the bidding documents may be obtained from Turnipseed Engineers, 4210 Columbia Road, Building 3, Augusta, Georgia 30907, upon receipt of \$125.00.

Digital copies of the documents are not available.

Upon receipt of all documents in undamaged condition within 30 days after the date of opening of bids, half of the deposit will be refunded.

The difference between the deposit and the amount refunded represents the cost of reproduction. No refund will be made for documents received after 30 days or in damaged condition.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.
