ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed Bids for the construction of the **Sewerage System Improvements, New Pump Stations and Sewer Lines, April 2019** will be received, by the **Town of Saluda at Town Hall, 100 South Jefferson Street, Saluda, South Carolina 29138**, until **2:00 p.m.** local time on **Thursday, May 30, 2019** at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read. **No submitted bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids for a period of ninety (90) days.** The Project consists of construction of:

Division One – New Submersible Pump Stations

Replacement of three existing sewage pump stations including new concrete wetwell's, submersible pumps, controls, piping, electrical, sitework, SCADA, painting, demolition of existing pump stations, and appurtenances.

Division Two – Sewer Line Rehabilitation

Rehabilitation of approximately 18,908 linear feet of 6 – 12 inch sewer lines by pipe bursting, video surveying and cleaning of approximately 120,000 linear feet of sewer, including service connections, rehabilitation of manholes and appurtenances.

Division Three – Gravity Sewer Lines and Force Main

Replacement of approximately 13,700 linear feet of 8 – 12 inch gravity sewer and 4,500 linear feet of 4 – 8 inch force main, including manholes, service connections and appurtenances.

Time of construction is **270** consecutive calendar days for Divisions One and **365** consecutive calendar days for Division Two and Division Three 365 days.

Bids will be received in **one or more general contracts**. Bids shall be on a lump sum and unit price basis, with additive alternate bid items as indicated in the Bid Form.

All Bidders must have or be capable of acquiring a State of South Carolina General Contractors License with a classification in Water and Sewer prior to bid award. Documentation of these qualifications will be required prior to bid award. See Instructions to Bidders, Article 13.09.

Ben Turnipseed Engineers, Inc., in Atlanta and Augusta** on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of **8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

Printed copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office, during the hours indicated above, upon payment of a deposit of **\$350.00** for each set. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 30 days after receipt of Bids will receive a **partial** refund. Non-Bidders, and Bidders who obtain more than one set of the Bidding Documents, will receive a refund of **\$175.00** for documents returned in good condition within the time limit indicated above. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to **“Turnipseed Engineers”**. upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via delivery service. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder’s date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A pre-bid conference will **not be held**.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders shall submit proof of qualifications to perform the Work as described in the Instructions to Bidders.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive informalities.

Section 746 of Title VII of the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2017 (Division A – Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2017) and subsequent statutes mandating domestic preference applies an American Iron and steel requirement to this project. All listed iron and steel products used in this project must be produced in the United States. The term “iron and steel products” means the following products made primarily of iron and steel: lined or unlined pipes and fittings, manhole covers and other municipal castings, hydrants, tanks, flanges, pipe clamps and restraints, valves, structural steel, reinforced precast concrete, and construction materials. The De Minimis and Minor Components Waivers apply to this contract.
