We had the opportunity to travel to Puebla, Mexico in June for a prayer retreat with some of our colleagues that work in Mexico and Central America. While in Mexico we also got to spend time with our supervisors and the decision has been made for us to transfer from Puerto Lempira to Copan, Honduras for our last few months with the IMB. After a few days in Copán, William returned to Puerto Lempira to pack up our things and to say goodbye. Amanda and Liam spent a few days at the beach with Amanda's mother. They had a great time relaxing together and resting from all of the traveling. We returned to Copán on July 7th and have spent the last few days settling in to a new home and getting acquainted with a new town. We are looking forward to traveling to some of the villages where the Collins have been working and getting to know the people that we will be teaching and helping. We will share more about the people and the work we will be doing next month.

As we go through all of these changes we are thankful for all of you who pray for us. It is of great help and encouragement to us. We would ask that you continue to pray for us, especially in our new assignment. Our two-year term with the IMB will be completed in October. Please pray we will finish well in the final few months of our term. As always, we would love to hear from you and what God is doing in your life.
